Questionable PerspectivesBy fastidious oneAfter several months of giving this smaller reference book consideration, my verdict is "hung" about the usefulness and accuracy of some data. I have decided to keep this publication, if only for the sake of comparision along varying (or conflicting) sources.... Plate 16 is described incorrectly as a brocaded weaving from the Bergama region of Western Anatolia with a design of either flying birds or repeating saddles. However, it is clearly a (rare) Dosemealti Zili weaved in the mountain areas north of the city of Antalya by one of the Karakoyunlu confederates. The design is "ELI BELINDE" reciprocal.... Plate 17 bears a strong resemblance to prayer cicims from Kecimuhsine (a small village on the out-skirts of Konya) which weavings of this sort has all but vanished. It is described as a piece coming from the Obruk area near Konya. There are other examples which may be disputed as well. But this has fueled some of the passion behind my interest and development towards learning about (and collecting) certain antique examples. The DYEING references included within this publication are good and I totally agree with the premise that color is one of the most important attributes, if not principle. The subject of wool and preparation is also important. Although disagreements are wide among Turkish Flatweaves, Akatay Bey and I certainly share a special affinity for Anatolian nomadic kilims.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
